देश के सभी डेंटल कॉलेजों को एतद्वारा सूचित किया जाता है कि शिक्षा मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार ने छात्रों को उनके मूल जारीकर्ताओं से सीधे डिजिटल प्रारूप में प्रामाणिक शिक्षा दस्तावेज / प्रमाण पत्र प्राप्त करने की सुविधा के लिए डिजिटलॉकर के माध्यम से राष्ट्रीय शैक्षणिक डिपॉजिटरी (एन.ए.डी.) कार्यान्वयन सौंपा है और वे सभी संस्थानों से चाहते हैं कि अपने 10 साल के शैक्षणिक प्रमाणपत्र डेटा को जल्द से जल्द इस प्लेटफॉर्म पर पंजीकृत और अपलोड करें।।

All the dental colleges in the country are hereby informed that Ministry of Education, Government of India has assigned the National Academic Depository (NAD) implementation via DigiLocker to facilitate students to get authentic education documents/certificate in digital format directly from their original issuers and desired from all the Institutions to register and upload their 10-years academic certificate data on the platform at the earliest.

In this regard, the Executive Committee of the Dental Council of India in its meeting held on 12.10.2022 consider the said matter and after discussion & deliberation decided as under :

All the Dental Colleges in the Country are informed as under:-

(i) The Ministry of Education, Government of India has assigned the National Academic Depository (NAD) implementation via DigiLocker to facilitate students to get authentic educational documents/certificate in digital format directly from their original issuers.

(ii) The digital copy available in the DigiLocker will be treated at par with the original physical document as per Rule 9A of the information Technology (Preservation & Retention by Intermediary providing DigiLocker facilities) Rules, 2016.

(iii) A project called e-Sanad of the Ministry of External Affairs, has been integrated with DigiLocker-NAD, which helps in the verification process of the student going abroad.

(iv) The realization and effectiveness of digitalization in education sector depend upon how quickly all Institutional bodies register and

start accessing the DigiLocker-NAD system.

(v) All the Institutions to register and upload their 10-years academic certificate data (Degree, Marksheet, Admit card, Score card, etc.) through DigiLocker-NAD (<https://nad.digilocker.gov.in>).

Accordingly, all the dental colleges in the country are requested to upload their 10-years academic certificate data (Degree, Mark-Sheet, Admit Card, Score Card etc.) through DigiLocker-NAD (<https://nad.digilocker.gov.in>) to facilitate students to get authentic education documents/certificate in digital format directly from their original issuers for implementation of National Academic Depository (NAD), as requested by Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India, New Delhi.
