Academic Section Matter

5(2) **Proposed dental college namely Sanaka Institute of Dental Sciences, Durgapur (West Bengal) – Regarding**

The Executive Committee considered the **Joint Inspection Report** of Council's Inspectors Dr. Virendra Vadher, Raipur (Chhattisgarh) and Dr. Rakesh A Singh, Navi Mumbai (Maharashtra) carried out on 2nd & 3rd December, 2024 for **establishment of a new dental college in the name of Sanaka Institute of Dental Sciences, Durgapur (West Bengal) with 100 BDS seats** for the Academic Year 2025-26, alongwith the suggestions of the UG Sub-Committee (4.3.2025), and after discussion and deliberation decided as under:-

The applicant be asked to immediately fulfill the following deficiencies and furnish the Compliance Report within 7 days, to this Council, positively, for furtherance in the matter:-

Sr. No.	There are following deficiencies:-
1.	There is a mandatory requirement of a separate and exclusive Central Library for dental students. The inspection report clearly indicates that it is shared with Medical Library in the Medical College.
2	Equipments:- The inspection report shows presence of the following equipments and facilities OPG, Plaster dispenser, Hydraulic Press and few Units of Phantom Lab. However, mere presence of these does not make these equipments and facilities functional. They should be in functioning condition at the time of inspection.
3	There is mandatory requirement of separate Boys & Girls Hostel in a dental institution. As per the inspection report there is no separate Boys & Girls Hostel available in the college and even Staff Quarters are not available.

5(25) **Government Dental College & Hospital, Srinagar (Jammu & Kashmir) – Regarding**
