In continuation of this office Circular No.DE-MDS(Gen)Admission-2021/2262 dated 06.10.2021 on the subject cited above and to say that the Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi, vide its Public Notice No.V.12025/154/2021-DE dated 10.11.2021, has lowered down the qualifying cut-off by 23.029 percentile for each category of candidates for NEET-MDS 2021 as under:-

2. In view of extension of cut-off date for admission to MDS Courses for the academic session 2021-22 by the Central Government, the Principals of all the dental colleges are hereby directed to upload, by using their already allotted login credentials, the details of students, admitted in MDS Courses at their dental institution for the academic session 2021-2022, on DCI Website, on or before the last date of admission i.e. **20<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 (12.00 midnight)**, positively, failing which DCI shall not entertain details of any students in any circumstances. The other contents of the earlier Circular dated 06.10.2021 would remain the same.

Similarly, the Dental Colleges facing any difficulty in uploading the details of foreign students in the absence of registration with respective State Dental Council, on DCI website, after admissions, however, are hereby again advised to send complete details of admission of such foreign student to this Council by e-mail only [secy-dci@nic.in](mailto:secy-dci@nic.in) on or before 20.11.2021 (12.00 midnight), this relaxation is applicable only to an admission to MDS Courses of foreign students, but not for Indian students.
