

Sir,

In continuation to the circulars under reference and in pursuance of Order dated 30.07.2020 in M.A. No.1282/2020 in W.P. (C) No.76/2015 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the undersigned is again directed to re-iterate the following, for its strict compliance:-

- (i) the dental colleges are permitted to upload the details of students admitted in MDS Course(s)/PG Diploma Course(s) only for the academic session 2020-2021, on DCI Website on or before 31.08.2020 (12:00 midnight).
- (ii) these admissions shall be subject to fulfillment of the requirement of registration by the student with the respective State Dental Council on or before 31.10.2020 only for the current academic year.
- (iii) no request for further extension of date for uploading the details of MDS students shall be considered in any circumstances including any excuse or reason of technical fault etc. DCI shall, for all intents and purposes, accept only the details uploaded on its Website. The subsequent e-mails, hard copies or in any form shall not be entertained in any circumstances.
- (iv) the college concerned shall be responsible for any wrong / incorrect information and the list so uploaded by the college shall be final only after its verification by the competent authority of respective State Government / UT / GOI and inconformity with the statutory provisions of regulations, guidelines etc. framed by the State Government consistent with that of DCI.
- (v) In case, any admission(s) is/are made in violation of the Dental Council of India, Master of Dental Surgery Course Regulations, 2017 or the Time Schedule for the academic session 2020-21 or non compliance of any above direction for uploading the details of the students on DCI website or in violation of the provisions of the Dentists Act and Regulations made thereunder, the college authorities shall be liable to discharge such students and the necessary action against the college shall be taken by the Council as per the provisions of Dentists Act and Regulations made their under or any other action as it may deemed fit in the facts and circumstances of each case.


