PUBLIC NOTICE

The Worthy President of Dental Council of India is pleased to bring to the notice of General Public and all concerned dental institutions and their affiliating Universities that the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) was approved by the MHRD and launched by Hon'ble Minister of Human Resource Development on 29th September 2015. This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception".

2. The Dental Institutions have stated participating in the NIRF Ranking Framework from the year 2020. 117 Dental Institutions have also participated for the year 2021 and the Hon'ble Union Education Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhanji, Government of India has released the India Rankings 2021 on 09.09.2021, including the dental institutions (for other details kindly click the link <https://www.nirfindia.org/2021/DentalRanking.html>).

3. The President, further, congratulates the Principals of the first 40 dental colleges and also puts his appreciation on record to all the dental institutions those participated in National Institutional Ranking Framework system of educational institutions for India Rankings 2021.

It is expected that more and more dental colleges shall participate for NIRF Rankings in the coming year/s from 2022 and onwards.
